2. You will be notified of the results of the registration by email by 14 February 2017. In case of over-subscription, admission to the course will be decided by lottery. Unsuccessful candidates can collect their cheques from the General Office of the Center for Language Education from 14 February 2017 onwards. Unfortunately the Center for Language Education cannot refund any additional costs which applicants may incur when obtaining their cheques.
