Forms and payment which are submitted after this deadline will only be considered if the course is not yet full.

3. You will be notified of the results of the registration by email by 12 September 2019. In case of over-subscription, admission to the course will be decided by lottery. Refund of course fees for unsuccessful applicants will be arranged in 4 - 6 weeks' time after the end of the registration period.
4. Course fees are not refundable once an applicant is admitted to a course.
5. A certificate of attendance will be awarded to each participant on meeting the attendance requirement of 80%.
