Registration:

1. Fill in an [online registration form](http://register.cle.ust.hk/L3) (<http://register.cle.ust.hk/L3>).

Pay a course fee of HK\$2,780/3,200 (staff members) or HK\$1,600/\$1,870 (students) by credit cards or e-wallets. After successful payment, you will receive an instant message confirming your payment and completion of your registration. Only paid registrations will be considered. If you do not complete the payment process, your registration will become invalid. Subject to sufficient enrolment, places will be allocated on a **first-come-first-served** basis.

Please return the completed application form together with a payment advice to CLE General Office (Room 3399, Lifts 17-18) in person or by email (lc13@ust.hk) on the same day.

2. The registration cannot be withdrawn once a place is confirmed. Your place and course fee paid are not transferrable.
3. Registration and payment should be completed by **12:00 noon on 18 December**. Applications after this deadline will only be considered if the course is not yet full.
4. You will be notified of the results of the registration by email on 23 December 2020. In case of under-subscription, the course will be cancelled and you will be refunded in full. Refund of course fees for unsuccessful applicants will be arranged in 4 - 6 weeks' time after the end of the registration period.
5. A certificate of attendance will be awarded to each participant on meeting the attendance requirement of 80%.
6. The Center for Language Education has the discretion over the allocation of places and the availability of the courses.
